<i>Paph hirsutissimum</i>		Lehua's JEM II' AM/AOS	An outcross of two fantastic examples of this spring blooming species. Huge, distinctive flowers on tall stems. This species forms amazing specimen plants that are very easy to maintain.	\$150.00
<i>Paph ciliolare</i>			A selfing of this rare and notoriously difficult species. Not recommended for beginners, but well worth the effort to grow. The parent has good vigor and is a fine example of this species. ***very limited***	\$250.00

<p><i>Paph volonteatum</i></p>			<p>Most of the <i>Paph volonteatum</i> we have seen on the market lately are actually (<i>hookerae x volonteatum</i>). Then foliage gives them away, and closer examination will confirm it. This is a sibling cross of two jungle collected specimens. <p><i>Paph rothschildianum</i></p>			<p><i>Paph rothschildianum</i> 'Paradise City' has not been to judging yet, but has the potential to be a strong FCC. The color is outstanding and the form is excellent. 'Paph Paradise' received an 86 point AM/AOS on its first bloom. The petals and sepals are very wide and the color is intense. It is very likely to be upgraded to an FCC on a future bloom. This is a 'can't miss' cross that should produce some of the finest roths ever seen.</p>	<p style="text-align: right;">\$350.00</p>
<p><i>Paph rothschildianum</i></p>			<p>Two more potential FCC plants meet up here. 'Paph Paradise' is dark and has very wide segments. 'Big Papa' has great color and is a huge flower. The AM came on a second spike this spring, so probably not quite as large and full as the earlier spike. I was at the judging where it was awarded...outdoors in some crazy hot weather. Paph	 Leonard's Pride 'Petrus' FCC/AOS, SM/CSA	 lowii 'Alentejo'	<p>Our Leonard's Pride is simply stunning. Lately it has been in bloom for 8-9 months out of the year. It received an 87 point SM/CSA...I rarely see CSA scores much higher than 81. One judge told me that if all 5 flowers had been fully open it would have scored a gold medal over 90 points. We have tried many times to get this plant to breed and FINALLY we have good germination with one of our very best lowii. Looking for an improved Juliis type flower here. 'Alentejo' has brighter color, 'Paph Paradise' is darker and larger. Either way we expect both versions of the cross to give is an improved version of Paph Julius. This cross should produce some excellent results, as both parents have superb color, size and vigor. These can bloom in 3 years from flask under ideal condtions. Crossed to this very full, round, wide-petalled Winesap we should see some excellent results. Expect large, well formed red flowers on strong stems. <p>Paph</p>	 <p><i>helenae</i> 4n</p>	 <p>Emerald Ring 'Auxerrois' AM/AOS</p>	<p>A large step in teacup breeding...we used a tetraploid <i>helenae</i> with one of our very best yellow complex. This should give us an improved version of In-Charm Topaz. Hopefully we will see better fertility in the next generation from this hybrid. The plants will be a nice manageable size. <p>Paph</p>	 <p>King Charles</p>	 <p>Ruby Boy Wonder 'Malbec' AM/AOS</p>	<p>This should be an improved version of our Paphiopedilum Paradise in Burgundy cross. The plants should have attractive foliage with flowers ranging from deep pink through burgundy on strong stems. There should be many awards from this cross.</p>	<p>\$150.00</p>
<p>Paph</p>	 <p>Jacob's Dream</p>	 <p>Jacqueline's Sprin Moon 'Viognie</p>	<p>Jacob's Dream is 62% <i>venustum</i> , with <i>sukhakulii</i> and <i>mastersianum</i> making up the balance. The result was some true yellow color in many of the progeny (sorry about the spray damage in the photo). Crossing this to our largest and fullest green and white should help get some size and form, and hopefully we will capture some bright yellows. The dark color from <i>Paph anitum</i> comes through, and the roth provides good size and form. Crossing to <i>Paph philippinense</i> will increase the flower count and give long petals. 'JEM' is a proven breeder, that imparts vigor and also produces high quality offspring.
