| <i>Paph rothschildianum</i> |  Paradise City' |  Paph Paradise' AM/AOS | Paradise City' has not been to judging yet, but has the potential to be a strong FCC. The color is outstanding and the form is excellent. 'Paph Paradise' received an 86 point AM/AOS on its first bloom. The petals and sepals are very wide and the color is intense. It is very likely to be upgraded to an FCC on a future bloom. We made this twice so we got a few more flasks from the second pod. These should be amazing! | \$350.00 |
| <i>Paph hainanense</i> |  sib cross | | By all accounts this is a synonym for <i>Paphiopedilum appletonianum</i> . We keep these labeled as hainanense as the foliage is distinctly different from typical appletonianum. A very easy to grow species that will bloom quickly from flask. A great choice for a beginner who wants to grow a species from flask as the plants don't get too big and they are very vigorous. | \$150.00 |

| <p><i>Paph amabile</i></p> |  sib cross | | <p>This is widely considered to be a synonym for <i>Paphiopedilum bullenianum</i> , but ours bloom at a different time of year and have some slight differences in flowers and foliage. If it is a synonym, perhaps ours originated from a different population. There is so much confusion among this appletonianum group. That's for the taxonomists to work out, we can just appreciate the beautiful foliage and flowers. A very easy to grow species.</p> | <p>\$150.00</p> |
| <p><i>Paph dayanum</i></p> |  sib cross | | <p><i>Paphiopedilum dayanum</i> is relatively uncommon in collections. It is a very striking flower that can be about 6" across. They have a reputation for being fussy growers, but we have had no trouble. We keep them shady and warm, but they are able to take cooler and intermediate conditions. The pod parent is shown here...with the actual pod in the bottom left of the photo!</p> | <p>\$175.00</p> |
| <p><i>Paph sukhakulii</i></p> |  Merlot' |  Nearly Black' | <p>One of our best colored sukhakulii, with very dark black spots, crossed to an almost solid black petaled select plant from Tokyo Orchids. We may see some nearly solid black petals, and will definitely see very dark pouches. 'Merlot' has a large flower with exceptional color. | <p><i>Paph lowii album</i></p> |  |  | <p>This is an outcross of two excellent examples of this species. 'Chablis' has broad, full segments and a high flower count. 'Golden Emperor' is a select plant from Tokyo Orchid Nursery. The flowers are large and have exceptional color. This is a 'can't miss' cross!</p> | <p style="text-align: right;">\$195.00</p> |
| <p><i>Paph ciliolare</i></p> |  | | <p>This is a pretty rare species in cultivation. It is similar to curtisii in appearance but it seems to be a little more fussy about cooler winter temperatures. | <p><i>Paph tigrinum</i></p> |  | <p>TBA'</p> | <p>'Gold Country' is a vigorous grower and a very high quality flower. The plant came from a seed pod set at the San Diego Zoo in plants that were siezed after an illegal importation. 'TBA' is a select seedling from the Orchid Zone. Bringing these two distinct lines together will provide vigor. Our awarded Mem. Sandra Pechter Song is a vigorous grower and is proving to be a fertile parent. We expect various shades of yellow through gold flowers on compact plants.
