<i>Paph armeniacum</i>			Double Magnum' has huge flowers...this year it produced two massive flowers n one spike. 'Premier Cru' has fantastic form and color. These came back pretty quickly from the lab so we expect some good vigor from this cross. We will only release a couple flasks of these as we want to grow out a population of them and bloom them ourselves. ***very limited***	<b>\$250.00</b>
<i>Paph vietnamense</i>			An American breeding line crossed with a Japanese line. Expect most to have well held petals, not the floppy stuff of the old breeding lines. 'Rosato' is a huge flower with petals held perfectly horizontally. 'Tokyo #1' was fading when the photo was taken, but you can see the full, round form...very flat. The pouch color was quite intense as well. These should be excellent. ***limited***	<b>\$250.00</b>

<p><i>Paph venustum</i></p>	 <p>sib cross</p>		<p>This strain came from Taiwan. The plants are very small, but the flowers are quite flat and have amazing red color and bold spots. The other parent had even darker color but I can't track down the photo anywhere. Very easy to grow...a good flask for novice growers. These usually bloom pretty quickly from flask, often in just over a year with good culture.</p>	<p style="text-align: right;"><b>\$150.00</b></p>
<p><i>Paph fairrieanum</i></p>	 <p>Magnum'</p>	 <p>Tavel'</p>	<p>As the name implies, 'Magnum' is a huge flower. The color is also quite good, with bold, well defines stripes. 'Tavel' is also very large, especially for an album form. These should all bloom out 'type'. The flowers should be very darkly striped, and we expect some real whoppers from this cross. the next generation will produce massive albums from a sib cross.</p>	<p style="text-align: right;"><b>\$175.00</b></p>

<b>Paph</b>	Delightfully Venus 'Sangria'	Petula's Flare 'Magnum'	<p>Paph venustum hybrids bring wonderful color and spots, but they tend to be small. Using a huge Petula's Flare (over 15 cm across), we hope to get some larger flowers with bold spots on the petals. Interesting potential for some unique things from this cross.</p>	<b>\$150.00</b>
				
<b>Paph</b>	Wonder Web 'Grenache'	Petula's Flare 'Magnum'	<p>We didn't even let Paph Wonder Web 'Grenache' fully open before we popped off the pouch and pollinated it. When we saw the big, fat petals we knew right away that Petula's Flare 'Magnum' would be the ideal parent. We expect big, shapely pinks with very few, if any, spots on the petals. <p><b>Paph</b></p>			<p>We expect some darker flowers with bold spots on the petals here. There should be a strong green background color as well. The venustum influence should still be strong enough to keep the plant size small. There should be some nice colors from this cross.</p>	<p style="text-align: right;"><b>\$150.00</b></p>
<p><b>Paph</b></p>			<p>And now for something completely different! Ford Hutchcraft is 75% primulinum and 25% complex Paph hybrid. Expect large yellow/green flowers produced sequentially. A very unique direction of breeding.</p>	<p style="text-align: right;"><b>\$150.00</b></p>
<p><b>Paph</b></p>			<p>The goal here is to get big spots on pink and green petals. Both parents have great color. Wonderfully Wood brings the big spots and Urban Vogue brings more pink and is a much larger flower. The flowers were fading by the time we took the photo, it was more impressive in person. <p><b>Paph</b></p>			<p>We love fairrieanum hybrids. This should be interesting as we have never made a fairrieanum cross with a black petaled flower. We should see very dark flowers with the distinctive fairrieanum shape. We made this cross twice, with two different fairrieanum plants. <p><b>Paph</b></p>			<p>This cross aims to make a smaller version of Paph Toni Semple (<i>haynaldianum x richardianum</i>). <i>Paph richardianum</i> is like a smaller Paph lowii so we should see more compact plants with flowers that resemble Toni Semple.</p>	<p style="text-align: right;"><b>\$150.00</b></p>
