<i>Paph druryi</i>			The pod parent was the best example of this species I have ever seen. I sold it for a big price, but got this pod from it first. 'Mamman' is an old jungle collected plant. We should see some great flowers from this cross, as well as good vigor as these are unrelated lines.	<b>\$195.00</b>
<i>Paph callosum</i>			This cross will produce a mixture of type and vinicolor flowers. The type plant came from a cross that produced vinis so it should carry the gene. These come from two distinct breeding lines so we will have excellent vigor as well as high quality flowers. Easy to grow from flask!	<b>\$150.00</b>

<p><i>Paph rothschildianum</i></p>	 <p>Tempranillo' AM/AOS      Jordon Winter' FCC/AOS</p>	<p>Tempranillo' is the only roth documented to have 7 flowers on one spike. I have heard claims from others that they have bloomed plants with 7, but nobody has produced a photo. It received an 88 point AM/AOS on its first bloom. We make it work too hard to get upgraded to an FCC, but maybe someday. 'Jordon Winter' is simply one of the very finest roths in the world. Sorry, I didn't take a photo of the plant when I got the pollen. We will release <b>ONE flask</b> from this cross, and that's all.</p>	<p style="text-align: right;"><b>\$500.00</b></p>
<p><i>Paph hangianum</i></p>		<p><i>Paphiopedium hangianum</i> is usually a slow growing species. This is a selfing of a plant that grows like a weed. I have never seen one of these grow so well. <p><i>Paph urbanianum</i></p>		<p>A sibling cross of two excellent examples of this species. Bright green stripes on the dorsal and deep colors in the pouch and petals really set this flower off. This brought in some Japanese breeding. Burgundy Thunder comes from our breeding. We are expecting BIG reds with a yellow background. <p><b>Paph Berenice</b></p>			<p>This remake of the classic primary hybrid should be fantastic. We reserve the 'Paph Paradise' clonal name for the very best plants in our collection. In that case both parents carry that name. The philippinense has the potential for an FCC someday (hard to tell in ths tiny photo, but it is amazing). The lowii has huge flowers with amazing color.
